Statement by the University of Tabriz Condemning the Aggression Against Iran's Peaceful Nuclear Facilities

In continuation of the hostile and unlawful campaign of the Zionist regime against the Islamic Republic of Iran, and amidst its repeated violations of international law through acts of aggression, sabotage, and targeted assassinations, we have now witnessed a grave escalation. In the early hours of this morning, the United States government committed a blatant act of aggression by targeting Iran's peaceful nuclear facilities in Natanz, Fordow, and Isfahan—sites that operate under international safeguards and serve solely scientific and civilian purposes.

These criminal acts, supported or tolerated by complicit powers, represent a clear violation of the United Nations Charter and international norms, and further endanger the security and stability of the region. Attacks on civilian infrastructure, particularly those associated with peaceful nuclear activities, mark a dangerous precedent and a desperate attempt to obstruct the progress of Iran's scientific community.

The University of Tabriz strongly condemns this reckless aggression, and firmly asserts the inalienable right of the Iranian people—enshrined in international treaties—to develop and utilize nuclear technology for peaceful purposes. These aggressive measures, whether carried out directly or indirectly, will never succeed in halting the intellectual, scientific, and technological momentum of the Iranian nation.
